# 3-Day Workshop Summary

Join us for a multi-day photography workshop in Glacier National Park led by renowned photographer Jack Bell. With guided access to sunrise and sunset light, iconic locations, and hidden gems, you'll capture stunning landscapes, wildlife, and water features in their peak season. Meet other creatives and advance your photography skills in the Crown of the Continent. All workshop logistics, transportation, 2 meals per day, and instruction are included—just bring your camera and your curiosity!

## Dates, Time, Location

This workshop runs from **11:00 AM on the first day through 1:00 PM on the final day**. All shooting will take place within Glacier National Park from West Glacier. Exact meet-up locations will be provided after booking.

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## Cost

The workshop cost is **\$895 per person** and includes all instruction, transportation during photo days, two meals per day (a hearty sack lunch and a catered picnic-style breakfast or dinner), and full planning support. On June 1st, the workshop rate increases to \$1,035, so we encourage early registration to secure your spot.

Lodging is not included, but we offer optional lodging add-ons, which includes an airport shuttle. (See page 6)



# Meet Jack Bell:



As a permitted guide service in Glacier National Park, we prioritize backcountry safety, seamless transportation, and expert support throughout your journey.

# 3-Day Itinerary\*

## Day 1: Welcome and Evening Light, 11 am - 9 pm

Arrive, settle in, and join us for a casual workshop welcome followed by an early - afternoon shooting session focused on expansive lake reflections, colorful glacial rocks, and flowing water. We'll close the day with a sunset session in one of Glacier's most scenic lake and mountain settings, paired with a catered, picnic-style dinner in the field.



## Day 2: Iconic Going to the Sun Road, 6 am - 1 pm

Spend the full day exploring and photographing along the legendary Going-to-the-Sun Road, capturing alpine and glacial views, wildlife sightings, waterfalls, and Glacier's most iconic vistas. We'll start the day with a morning shoot in prime light, paired with another catered picnic-style lunch in a peaceful outdoor setting.



## Day 3: Sunrise Reflections and Farewell, 5 am - 12 pm

We'll greet the day with a sunrise session focused on calm water compositions and towering mountain backdrops. After a warm, catered breakfast in the field, we'll close with final tips, group reflections, and farewells — leaving you inspired and full of new images and insights.

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\*Itinerary subject to change based on weather, conditions, and wildlife detours.

# Additional Details:

## Getting Here:

- Airport: Glacier Park International Airport (FCA) is just 30 minutes from the National Park.
- Train: Amtrak's Empire Builder stops daily at the Whitefish Depot.

*If you book our Lodging Add-On, we'll handle your airport or train shuttle and provide daily pickup and drop-off from your lodging*

## Activity Level:

Expect up to 4 miles of hiking/walking per day on moderate terrain, with minimal elevation gain. Our pace is relaxed and photography-focused. We take plenty of extended breaks for instruction and shooting. Do not let the physical requirements deter you; we can accommodate all abilities, just ask!

## Weather:

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
July and August are typically warm, dry, and clear, with long daylight, highs in the 80s°F. September shifts to fall conditions with cooler 40s°F and still warm during the day.

## Equipment:

A full packing list will be provided after booking. You'll also receive a recommended equipment guide.

## What's Not Included:


- One meal per day (2 per day are included with the workshop)

- Glacier National Park entrance fee (\$35 for 7 days)
- Travel arrangements for getting to the area via car, flight, or train.
